

Five Considerations for Re-Gathering as a Church for Worship:

1. **Feeling any not-normal symptoms? Please stay home.**

- COVID-19 symptoms aren't as uniform as we want them to be, so a simple way to avoid infecting others is to stay home if you have any physical symptoms that aren't normal to you.

2. **Standard COVID-19 wisdom/cautions still apply.**

- People 65 years old or over, people who are immuno-compromised, people with diabetes and cardio-pulmonary issues are encouraged to stay home and participate via livestream.
- Keep your appropriate six-foot social distancing in mind. Parents, our kids will need help with this, so let's be patient with them.
- To reduce cleaning requirements and limit the area of possible contamination, only the sanctuary and adjoining rest rooms will be open.

3. **Clean hands before you come and after you get here.**

- The church will have large pumps of hand sanitizer for common use, but everyone is encouraged to bring their own personal bottle.
- We have some personal 4oz. bottles on hand that we can give away for the first few Sundays we are back.

4. **Wearing a face mask**

- Wearing a facemask doesn't keep one from *contracting* the virus but will aid in preventing one from *giving* the virus.
- All who plan to attend public worship are encouraged to wear a facemask. Please bring your own.
- Those in the pulpit area will not be wearing masks as they will be more than exceeding the social distancing guidelines and need to be without a mask for an effective livestream.

5. **Use "digital" or personally-printed worship tools during the service.**

- We have removed all hymnals, psalters, and pew Bibles since there's no real way to sanitize them effectively after each service.
- Bring up the order of service from our website (www.pilgrimpca.org) on your tablet or smart phone. Downloading it ahead of time is best, since the internet is notoriously unreliable.
- The church will provide a printed order of service and copies of the hymns, psalms, and other lyrics we will be using.
