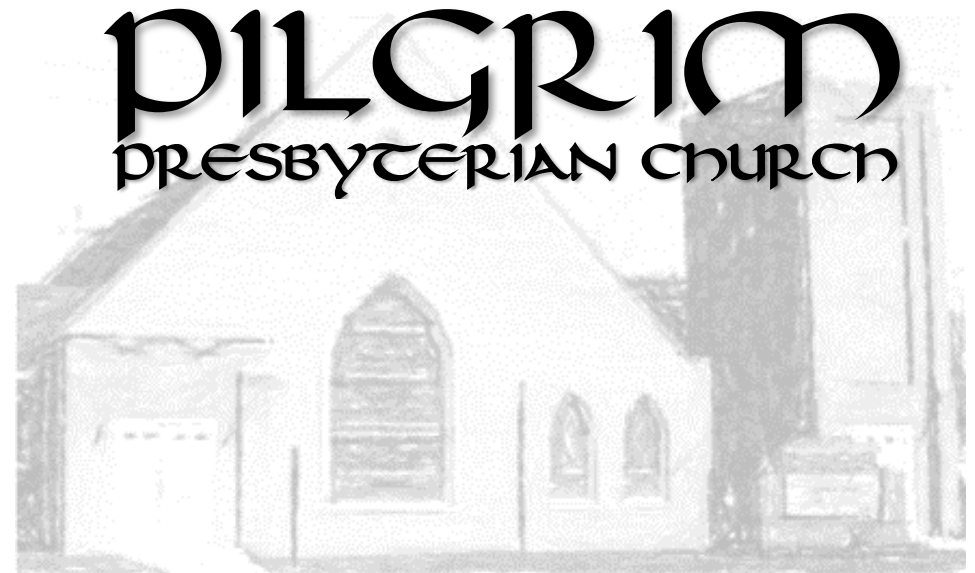

## **We Confess our Sin**

Minister: Blessed Heavenly Father, you offered us all your blessings when your Son announced "Blessed are the poor in spirit"

**People: but we have been rich in pride.**

Minister: Blessed are those who mourn

**People: but we have not known much sorrow for our sin.**

Minister: Blessed are the meek

**People: but we are a stiff-necked people.**

Minister: Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness

**People: but we are filled to the full with other things.**

Minister: Blessed are the merciful

**People: but we are harsh and impatient.**

Minister: Blessed are the pure in heart

**People: but we have impure hearts.**

Minister: Blessed are the peacemakers

**People: but we have not sought reconciliation.**

Minister: Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness

**People: but our lives do not challenge the world.**

Minister: Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me

**People: but we have hardly made it known that we are yours.**

Minister: Your Law is holy and your blessings are perfect, but they are both too great for us. You alone are blessed.

**People: We plead with you to forgive our sins and give us the blessing of your righteousness. In the name of your Son, Jesus, we ask. Amen.**
